The Hendrick Hudson Free Library is starting a program for you and your preschool child. Step Up for Literacy is a program for you and your 2 or 4 year old child to learn the best ways to work together to develop reading skills.

Step Up for Literacy hopes to give all children an equal opportunity in school by providing pre-school literacy experiences for English Language Learners and children who do not attend pre-school.

Step Up for Literacy is a free program with ten sessions that can be scheduled at a time you and your child can come to the Library for an hour. You will also receive books and other materials to bring home so you and your child can continue to read together.

If you cannot attend with your child, another adult such as a grandparent or aunt or uncle or older sibling may attend. If transportation to the Library, which is located on Kings Ferry Road in Montrose, is a problem, we will assist you in getting to the Library from your home.
